President's Report

2011 has been a great and productive year for the Georgia Association that can be only attributed to the passion, energy and talents of our most valuable resource which is our people of the Association.

I wanted to start the year with a hard hat and lunch box mentality so I drafted a letter encouraging and challenging the my fellow Board members to roll up their sleeves and go to work creating programmatics for our constituents and enhancing our already existing programs for our members. The board took that challenge and executed on the objectives that we set in many of our planning sessions. In this new success model we have established many partnerships with organizations that support our vision and mission: Atlanta Track Club, Polytan USA, Emory University, Georgia Tech, Mill Creek High School, Nealwear sports, Tillery Wines, Foot Solutions, CoachO, Mondo, Support Clean Sport, City of Atlanta, Optimus Energy and Mix1.

In 2011, we were able to hit the following markers:

2011 saw our youth track and field events go live to 20,000 viewers via live streaming. The team was led by the new face of USATF Georgia Association Current World Record holder in the 400 meter hurdles and Olympian Kevin Young along with support staff Jim Norvill and Bobby Ray.

Under our communications umbrella we have implemented the new face of our association by launching our new webpage that is easy to maneuver and focuses on the achievements of our membership. We continue to utilize social media (Twitter, Facebook) to communicate with our social media savvy members and we have made a paradigm change by utilizing constant contact to support our marketing and communication initiatives. We have also made strides with our local media (11 Alive) to boost our footprint outside our membership.

Our Coaches Advisory group utilized conference call technology to deliver additional training opportunities via the coach's roundtable.

For our coaches, USATFGA worked with our National Director of Coaches - Terry Crawford, to bring the USATF Level II School to Georgia Tech. USATFGA also hosted two Level I schools in the 2011 calendar year (Georgia State University / Southern Poly).

In 2011, the USATFGA Board Meetings and participation increased with the use of the following technologies: Fuze meeting, free conference calling and Skype (which helped us continue to be efficient as a group and reduce our negative impact on the planet). The board meetings were open to the public which maintained transparency of the board and its officers.

Active recruitment of our volunteer base to help support our mission: By-Law review committee, Hall of Fame Committee, Budget and Finance Committee, Tally Committee and Grievance Committee and under the leadership and vision of our Coaches Advisory Committee we have been able to establish sub-committees that include coaches education and a medical committee which is chaired by Josh Glass.

With continued cooperation of our Athletes Advisory, Masters, Youth, and Track & Field sport committees and guidance of the Board of Directors, we were able to combine the Open and Masters Track and Field Championships along with the developmental track meet to maximize our resources. This afforded an opportunity for our future Olympians to see our current stars compete right next to them and inspire them to continue to do great things in the sport.

In 2011 an Association Report Card that will be introduced at a strategic is planning session that is scheduled for September 11, 2011. This will be publicized to our membership before the end of the year.

Sanctioning is running ahead of last year's record-breaking pace with four months left in the year.

The hammer cage and the steeple chase at Westlake are up and operational and were the site of the regional steeple and hammer competitions.

Our officials group continues to have 200+ registered officials

Club membership is at an all time high.

Individual membership is getting closer to 4,000 members which is a all time high.

The first USATFGA Hall of Fame class was enshrined and included Leroy Walker, Edwin Mosses, Roger Kingdom, Forrest Spec Towns, Wyomia Tyus, Alice Coachman, Gwen Torrance and Paralympian Al Mead.

USATFGA received a proclamation from the city of Atlanta naming August 14, 2011 USA Track & Field Georgia Hall of Fame Day, and each Hall of Fame inductee received a Phoenix Award from the Mayor - the highest award given to anyone by the City of Atlanta

As all organizations, we all have area (s) of opportunity:

- Create alternate streams of revenue (develop sponsorships and alliances with external organizations that share like philosophy).
- Faster communications to membership and build a more robust network with outside media.
- Develop more community outreach programs.
- Greater participation among all our 200+ officials.
- Continued improvement in the area of customer service.
- Additional board training to support a better team dynamic and Board conflict resolution.
- All sport committees performing at a fiscally sound level.
- Accurate accounting of Association assets.
- Marketing/Brand recognition.
- Marked improvement on strategic planning (Short/Long term).

- III. **Video Presentation – “Growing Athletic Excellence in Georgia”.** President Dube unveiled an inspirational 10-minute video collage of various Association events held throughout the year.

- IV. **President’s Awards:**

- V. **Keynote Speaker:** The USATF Georgia Association was very pleased to have Lionel Leach, USATF Division Chair - Youth Athletics, as our keynote speaker. Lionel’s wealth of experience has transformed young athletics into one of the most dominate divisions within USATF. Under his leadership, in just 4 years, the youth program has gone from a committee within the organization to its very own division. He helped to pass legislation to have a youth representative on the Board of Directors and doubled the overall youth budget to half a million dollars in the first four years. Lionel also was successful in standardizing chip timing as the official timing system used for the National Junior Olympic Cross Country Championships. He was able to move the organization into the 21st century by moving to a paperless registration for all 3 of the programs national championships. Lionel was also the main catalyst in adding the disabled and ambulatory 800 meters as an exhibition event into the Junior Olympics. Lionel was also the leader in developing the World Youth Trials that takes place on the odd year. This meet is used to develop USATF Youth International teams. For his great work he received the USATF President Award as well as the Distinguished Service Award in 2009.

Committee Reports - LDR

We Committee members were requested to write a report regarding goals and objectives for our Committee activities. A brief review of conceptual differences between goals and objectives is appropriate initially, as the two terms have similarities as well as differences. Both goals and objectives are needed if something is to be accomplished. Goals are long-term aims that one desires to accomplish. Objectives are concrete attainments that are achievable. Objectives are highly structured; goals are less so. Objectives can be clearly outlined, with specific budgetary, personnel, and supply needs. Goals are nebulous, and one can never say for certain whether they have been achieved.

With these notes in mind, let us examine the USATF-GA LDR program, and indicate goals and objectives - goals refer to general ideas about the program; objectives refer to specifics. Ever since the USATF program was mandated back in 1979, the goals have been to increase numbers of participants and increase quality of performance among those participating in each Association. It took awhile, but beginning in 1992 a program of racing opportunities was begun in the Georgia Association, with the specific objectives of 1) identifying various distances and types of terrain used for competition, 2) implementing various technologies for scoring and recording results, and 3) creating various methods for rewarding the best performers with meaningful and tangible "tokens" of value (money, trophies, medals, etc.). Each year, specific programs have been developed and implemented, and then evaluated in an attempt to improve the best offerings to athletes.

In 2010 we provided men and women each with two competitive opportunities:

- Atlanta Women's 5K (March 27, 2010- Atlanta Track Club was host club). Winner was Jennie Kormanik (17:07).
- Augusta Half Marathon (October 24, 2010-hosted by Augusta Sports Council) Winner was Leo Kormanik (1:09:36).
- Millen Milers XC 4.8 (November 13, 2010 – Millen Milers & More was host club). Male winner was Ken Youngers (26:57) and female winner was Holly Ortlund (27:52).

Each of the above winners was provided with a travel stipend to attend and compete in the equivalent USA National Championship race, with the results as follows:

- USA 5K National Championships, September 19, 2010, Providence, RI. Jennie Kormanik did not compete due to an injury.
- USA Half Marathon National Championships, January 30, 2011, Houston, TX. Leo Kormanik finished in 14th place, in a time of 1:05:26, missing the automatic Olympic Trials standard by a mere 26 seconds (1:05:00).
- USATF National Club XC Championships, December 10, 2010, Charlotte, NC. Ken Youngers finished 28th in the 50-54 year Age Group (37:07) and Ortlund finished in 91st place in the Open category (21:53).

The idea was to give these athletes the opportunity to raise their skill level by providing a top-level racing opportunity. Evaluation of the 2010 program was positive, with a desire to add another event to the 2011 program, namely a MUT trail event. The association has not had a MUT championship race in recent memory (if ever). A growing number of runners are participating in MUT races and the USA championships are in nearby Laurel Springs, NC.

2011 LDR Championship Program: For this budget year we will have 6 races @ 4 events – 3 opportunities each for men and women. Each winner will receive up to a \$750 travel stipend to a National Championship event in a related distance/terrain.

2011 LDR Championship Events

- Atlanta Women's 5K (March 26, 2011-Atlanta Track Club is host club). Top female finisher to receive \$750 travel stipend to USA 5K Championships at CVS/Caremark 5Km in Providence, RI on September 18, 2011
- Deep South 15K-XTERRA Georgia Trail Run Series Finale, Jackson, GA (June 4, 2011-Dirty Spokes is host club). Top male and female finisher to receive \$500 travel stipend to USA 10K Trail Championships at Continental Divide Trail race in Laurel Springs, NC on August 28, 2011.
- Millen Milers XC 4.8 (November 12, 2011-Millen Milers & More is host club). Top male and female finisher to receive \$750 travel stipend to USATF Club XC Championships in Seattle, WA on December 10, 2011.
- Atlanta Half Marathon (November 24, 2011 – Atlanta Track Club is host club). Top male finisher to receive \$750 travel stipend to USA 15K Championships at Gate River Run 15K in Jacksonville, FL on March 11, 2012.

The 5 km women's race in March 2011 was an astounding success, with more than 2,000 finishers (a record), and with all but one of the ten fastest 5km road racing Georgia women participating. Likewise, the MUT race in June produced 2 winners who are thrilled with being awarded the opportunity to compete at the national level. We look forward to an exciting year of competitions.

The committee has planned a development program for Georgia LDR athletes; namely a sport science symposium to dovetail with the Millen XC races. Some funding has been allocated for elite athletes to defray the costs of attending. Dr. Dave Martin has long been behind the success of US LDR athletes; specifically and most recently Athens Olympic medalists Deena Kastor and Meb Keflezighi and Team USA California. The GA LDR committee, along with support and coordination from the Sports Medicine and Science sub committee (Coaches Education Committee) and the Athletes Advisory Committee have created an athlete development program to identify and support Georgia LDR athletes who have met Olympic Trials and/or national qualifying standards.

This initial year we will identify athletes who have or are pursuing Olympic Trials qualification standards as well as association LDR members at large. These athletes will be evaluated and have access to supplemental training aids in terms of support (testing/treatment) from the medical/scientific community to help in their training and development.

We will also have a distance summit in conjunction with the Millen Miler XC 4.8 Mile. Athletes will arrive in Millen Friday evening, compete Saturday morning and attend the summit on Saturday afternoon. They will be responsible for their transportation expenses and a portion of their meal costs; the Georgia Association will be responsible for shared accommodations, and a portion of meal costs; Millen Milers will be responsible for a portion of meals cost; in addition to championship host cost.

Other ideas for future consideration is to conduct development programs throughout the year in Rome and Jekyll Island, in addition to roundtable calls throughout the year in partnership with the Coaches Education, Athlete Advisory and Sports Medicine and Science committees.

Additionally, the Committee has considered the 2012 calendar and current Committee thoughts are to keep the Atlanta Women's 5K race and the MUT race on the calendar. This is primarily based on the support and assistance the committee has received from race management and athlete feedback. The committee is currently making inquiries with several races around the association to fill out the series calendar.

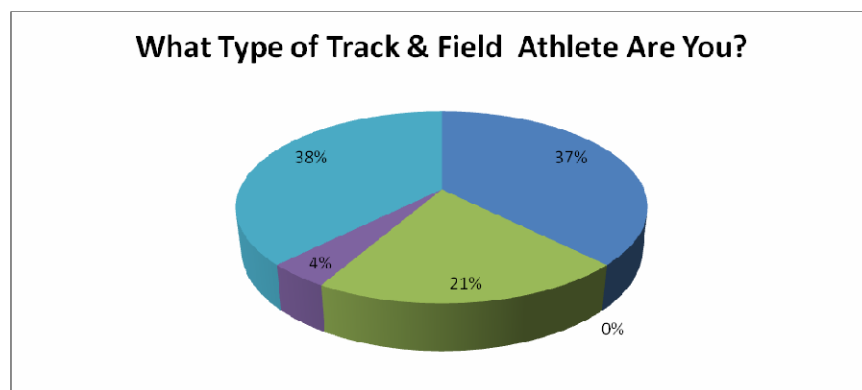

Cross Country

Our 2010 Cross Country season was rewarding and action packed. The Cross Country GA Youth clubs did a great job with our athletes and their creative nature and “eye” for detail made for some exciting meets. **KUDO’s** to Don Livingston (Peachtree City Running Club) ... My Savior for the Cross Country Committee. We started the season with a schedule of several Cross Country Developmental meets hosted by the individual Youth clubs. This preparation allowed us to have record numbers at our Developmental XC Meet and our GA Association XC Junior Olympic Championships held in Peachtree City at Oak Grove Elementary. With the guidance of Tracy Stevenson (Etowah TC) the athletes dressed up for Halloween at the Assoc XC Developmental Meet. Prizes were awarded to the best team spirit. Halloween Candy was handed out to the athletes “After the Competition.” We had 306 athletes registered for the Developmental Meet and fun for all. Our attendance for this preview meet tripled year over year.

The GA Association XC Junior Olympic Championship had over 500 athletes. We had more than any other USATF JO Association Championship. We had 17 clubs and 39 Unattached athletes compete (Up from 12 teams in 2009). We awarded our athletes with medals and all first (1st.) place athletes and teams also received a hat. Our officials stepped up once again and we had a great meet and a fantastic audience of spectators and vendors. We thank the PTC Flash team and their parents for managing the setup and concessions for this event.

The Region III XC Championship was held in Hagerstown, MD on November 19, 2010. There were 630 athletes of which 582 competed. Georgia had 19 athletes who traveled on the GA Association Bus (First Time) to Hagerstown, MD, to compete. The bus was very well received by the 48 people who traveled on the bus. The Youth Chair along with the support of her committee did not charge the USATF Qualifying athletes for their seats on the bus and the parents and family members were charged a nominal fee for this Championship trip. USATF Georgia had 201 athletes compete (almost one-third of the attendees) at the Region 3 XC Championships. Georgia once again placed well in the events. See attached spreadsheet.

The National Junior Olympic Cross Country Championship was held December 11, 2010 in Hoover, AL Georgia had a great showing at the Nat’l XC JO Championships. We had two athletes who stood out... Lindy Long of PTC Flash who came in 7th in the 5K event with a time of 19:23 and Raymond (Ty) McCormick of Lanier Running Club for the 5K Young Men’s event with a time of 15:28 (missed first by 6 seconds). Job well done! Our Georgia youth were well represented. Team Spirit for GA athletes could be felt throughout the venue.

The USA Track & Field 2010 Annual Meeting was held in Virginia Beach, VA. Your youth Chair represented Georgia as the delegate for the Youth Committee. Both Ron Williams and Eric Merriweather, youth coaches attended the Annual Meeting. They represented Georgia as a delegate to other committees. An annual committee report was previously submitted. Highlights- the new age division-Sub Bantam for the 2011 and the change to the Young Men to 3K instead of 5K for their event.

The Youth Committee met for the Annual Winter Meeting and Planning Session on February 26, 2011. This meeting was held at the Dekalb Park and Recreation Center in with 78 attendees. At copy of the minutes will be given for approval at the Annual Meeting.

Track and Field Season 2011

Area Preliminary Meets and Association Championships: The Northwest Area A Meet was held at Westlake HS, Atlanta, Ga., The Northeast Area B Meet was held at Strong Rock Christian, Locust Grove, GA, and the South Area C Meet was held at Starrs Mill HS, Peachtree City, GA. This was our second year using the new USATF central online data entry system, CoachO. Our Georgia clubs and athletes did very well submitting their entries using the new system. All of the summer meets were successful. No Protest were submitted. We had a total of 1795 (1476 in 2010) athletes register and 72 teams (68 in 2010) in 4193 entries (3876 in 2010) and 178 (164 in 2010) relays.

The Region III Championship was held at Mill Creek HS, Hoschton, GA. This meet had 2,765 athletes. Georgia was well represented with 60 teams (48 in 2010). We had 790 athletes compete and 109 relay teams. (77 in 2010). We had outstanding performances from Georgia with new Region 3 Records. Vendor participation was up from previous years. Meet was run smoothly.

The Georgia Association in 2011 would like to thank Starrs Mill High School and Mill Creek High School for their support. We also extend our sincere Thanks to the coaching staff s, administrators and team support at Starrs Mill High School and Mill Creek HS for getting us through our GA Association Championship and the Region 3 Championship with dedication and fantastic support.

The Georgia Association will be reimbursing for the entry fees for all Georgia Athletes who competed at **the National Track and Field Junior Olympic Championship at Wichita State, in Wichita, KS.** Georgia Association had 153 athletes compete and more than 25 relay teams at Nationals. Our Athletes showed outstanding performances. Congratulations to All Georgia Athletes!!!! A listing of the national finalist is on the website and will be submitted at the Annual Convention for your perusal.

However since the launch of our open and masters events in June, I have had the extensive opportunity to develop an array of interviews with many tiers of our running community.

Our meetings held in from May throughout June allowed an incredible platform for interviewing many athletes from our youth clubs to our masters. We were able to provide interesting topics of discussion from Olympians, collegiate coaches, youth club coaches, and even our officials. We got reports from Mr. Ralph Boston and even youngsters competing on clubs like Impact Track Club and the Titans Track Club.

We had many people willing to give their perspective on our sports and their current level of participation from coaching athletes at every level from Masters to youth, from "hammer to race walking". With the help of our Association's president, Mr. Ian Dube, "we" were able to document these interviews with video footage and post them on the Association's website. This first year has shown me the great variety and range of activities that are available to me to develop a more beneficial role as Athlete Advisory Chair.

During this first year I did not know what to expect but now I have realized the range and latitude that's given to become more creative and progressive within our association. I did not plan on utilizing any portion of the budget earlier in the year because I was not satisfied receiving the kinds of feedback from our athletes. However this will change in the future. With the formation of some high performance training events and local community outreach, I see a greater impact that the AAC will seek in the future. I look forward to providing some ideas and activities to the board that should impact the association in a truly positive way.

To: Board of Directors and Members,

The Budget and Finance Committee reports to the Board and primarily provides oversight to financial reporting and assists in acquiring consultants to perform an audit or other resources of accounting expertise. The committee's major project is to review the association's budget and provide recommendations to the board.

In regards to acquiring consultants to perform an audit we are now in the second attempt in two years. At this time we have received proposals from two of the previous (2010) bidders based on the request from the July 2011 board call. It should be noted that two of the three originally proposed firms merged requiring an extended search for an additional proposal.

Financial oversight includes assisting the Board with the integrity of the financial statements, compliance to legal or regulatory requirements, internal controls, and to comment on the functionality of each. The overall integrity of the financial statements could improve. Several items of substance should be disclosed. The proper value of fixed assets owned by the association as well as the asset value of the contract negotiated with Westlake High School should be reported. The distribution of stipends should be disclosed in the financials and reported to the IRS as non-employee compensation with associated form 1099 properly distributed.



Bylaw Review Committee – Summary of Committee Work

In February, 2011, the Bylaw Review Committee was assembled for the express purpose of (a) reviewing the Association's bylaws against the USATF bylaws and operating regulations, applicable state law, and current USATF GA policies and procedures, and (b) reviewing the operating procedures of each USATF GA committee.

Action taken as a committee:

- Adopted a set of operating procedures for the Bylaw Review Committee.
- Set aside review of committee operating procedures in favor of review of the USATF GA bylaws, citing time constraints (i.e., any proposed amendments required submission to the Membership 30 days prior to the Annual Meeting).
- Met weekly to review every Article and consider revisions that reflected current Association "best practices," to clarify ambiguous text, and to ensure conformity with USATF bylaws and operating regulations.
- Submitted a set of proposed amendments to the Membership for vote during the Annual Meeting. Material proposed amendments are as follows:
 - Removed the Executive Committee as a separate advisory or oversight body within the Association. Action taken in response to majority view that the existence of the Executive Committee is redundant in relation to the duties and responsibilities of the Association's Officers and/or Board of Directors.
 - Introduced a "good standing" requirement for Officer nominees.
 - Expanded the amendment Article to require submission of proposed bylaw amendments to the Bylaw Review Committee for recommendation to the Board, and to require submission of proposed amendments to committee operating procedures to the Board, each for Board approval. Introduced bylaw archival requirement.
 - Removed requirement that the Athlete Advisory Chair be "an active athlete representing the Georgia Association."
 - Revised the definition of "written notice" to include website posting. Action taken in response to recurring challenges to sufficiency of meeting notices.
 - Aligned commencement dates for Officers and committee chairs.
 - Rejected extending terms from 2 years to 4 years.
 - Rejected term limits.

Prior to the Annual Meeting, the Bylaw Review Committee will make available to the Membership a brief statement of rationale for material proposed amendments.

Georgia has an excellent participation in the background screening process. The largest problem is not submitting the Coach/ Volunteer Information form. If a coach/volunteer is listed on the current listing below and is not listed with a club, then he/she must contact the membership chair (Linda Bommicino) to have his/her membership number changed to the appropriate club.
