## AGE DIVISIONS & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

### Age Divisions

8 & under (born 2008 +)
9 - 10 (born 2009-2010)
11 - 12 (born 2007-2008)
13 - 14 (born 2005-2006)
15 - 16 (born 2003-2004)
17 - 18 (born 2001-2002)
* athletes born in 2000 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 7/28/2019



**Individuals:** Only U.S. citizens, aliens living in the United States and foreign exchange students are eligible to compete in these Championships. See the USATF Rules for more information and exceptions. A competitor must compete in his/her age division only. There will be no "moving up" in any events, including relays. Competitors in the 8 & Under, 9 - 10 and 11 - 12 age divisions may compete in a maximum of three (3) events, including relays. Competitors in the 13 - 14, 15 - 16 and 17 - 18 age divisions may compete in a maximum of four (4) events, including relays. Combined events are not included in the event count. All athletes must be 2019 members of USATF in good standing.

**Relay Teams:** Only registered 2019 USATF member clubs may enter a relay team(s). All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with and members of that club as part of their USATF membership. Visit [www.usatf.org/membership](http://www.usatf.org/membership).

Individual Entries: \$6 per event  
Relay Entries: \$24 per relay team  
Decathlon/Heptathlon: \$16 per event  
Triathlon/Pentathlon: \$10 per event

**Valid 2019 USATF Membership and Proof of Birth is required for participation.** Before registration, please ensure that the membership chair has received (via mail or fax) a copy of the athlete's Proof of Birth (copy of birth certificate, passport, certified baptismal record, driver's license or U.S. government identification). **WAIVER:** All athletes who participate in the USATF Junior Olympic Program must complete the Junior Olympic Participant Waiver and Release form. This form is already integrated in the online entry system and can be completed electronically; it can also be obtained via your association. All forms must be submitted at the first round of the Junior Olympic series.

**AWARDS:** USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals and the top three (3) relay teams in each event of each age division.

**ADVANCEMENTS:** The top 12 individuals and relay teams in each event of each age division will advance to the USATF Region 4 Championships to be held on July 4-7, 2019 at Winthrop University, Irwin Belk Track & Field Complex, 1162 Eden Terrace, Rock Hill SC 29730. Info:

The National Junior Olympic Championships will be held from Monday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> to Sunday, July 28<sup>th</sup> in Sacramento, CA. The top 5 athletes at the Region 4 Championships will qualify for the National Championships, in combined events the top 2 athletes will qualify. **POLE VAULT:** Due to facility limitations at Westlake HS, the OPEN pole vault will be contested at: **GALLOWAY ATHLETICS COMPLEX**  
**2400 Defoors Ferry Road, NW**  
**Atlanta, Georgia 30318**

**DECATHLON :** The Decathlon will also be affected by the pole vault limitations at Westlake HS. As a result, the decathlon will still be contested minus the pole vault. All other decathlon events will be contested. All decathletes who compete in the other 9 decathlon events will be advanced to the Region 4 Championships.

**IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN:** Will be posted at the venue.

**EVENT CHECK-IN:** There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Athletes must check in at these designated areas 45 minutes prior to the event's scheduled starting time. All athletes will be required to remain in the designated warm-up areas after checking in.

**COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS:** All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front on their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$5. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes at packet pick-up near the main gate entrance.

**EVENT RESULTS:** During competition, event results will be posted at [www.ptgrouponline.com](http://www.ptgrouponline.com)

**PROTESTS:** There will be a \$50 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

#### **RULES – CONDUCT & FACILITY:**

- Tents will only be allowed in the top rows of Stands. Check for signs before putting up Tents.
- No littering. The cost of using facilities is increasing because of cleanup. Please pick up, even if you are not the one who put it down! Please put trash in receptacles. Please clean up after yourself!
- Please Do NOT bring loud radios or music, pets, or unnecessary distractions to the meet.
- NO cooking or barbecuing.
- NO PETS allowed at the venues
- No selling of merchandise without permission from meet director.
- Please volunteer your help wherever needed!!!!
- Unacceptable behavior by coaches, athletes or spectators of any kind will result in removal from the Meets

**GATE ADMISSION FEES:** Day pass - \$5; Weekend pass - \$8; Four day pass - \$15. All coaches and volunteers on the USATF Youth Background cleared list can enter free of charge. Children 5 and under are free.
